PRE-OP INSTUCTIONS Conscious Sedation

Patients who have a clear understanding and expectation level before surgery have a greater peace of mind. The following instructions and information will help you prepare yourself and ensure that you oral surgery goes smoothly.

- 1. You may **not** have anything to eat or drink (including water) 6 hours prior to the appointment. You should, however, take any medications that your dentist has directed you to take before your surgery with a small sip of water.
- 2. A responsible drive (with a vehicle) MUST transport you to and from your appointment. In case of an emergency, your driver MUST REMAIN in the waiting area at all times during the surgery.

YOU MUST HAVE AN ADULT TO STAY WITH YOU FOR 24 HOURS AFTER SURGERY. YOU MUST NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED

- 3. Please wear loose fitting clothing with sleeves, which can be rolled up past the elbow and low-heeled shoes. Contact lenses (non-extended), jewelry, dentures, and nail polish must be removed.
- 4. Call the dental office as soon as possible if you have any of the following "cold" or "flu" symptoms, such as:

Stuffy nose Sore throat Cough Sinus drainage Fever

5. A parent or guardian must sign for and accompany anyone who is a minor under the age of 18 years of age.
